✓ Cardboard boxes of any kind - dry food, cosmetic and medicine boxes; roll cores, packing cartons (flattened)



✓ Paper grocery and take-away food bags of various sizes

✓ Food and beverage cartons & paper cups

✓ Newspapers, magazines and brochures, including glossy varieties

✓ Office and shredded paper, envelopes

✓ Old telephone directories

✓ Paper giftwrap (sticky tape removed)

✓ Hardcover and paperback books



*No!* Keep these out of your paper recycling!



✗ Food waste

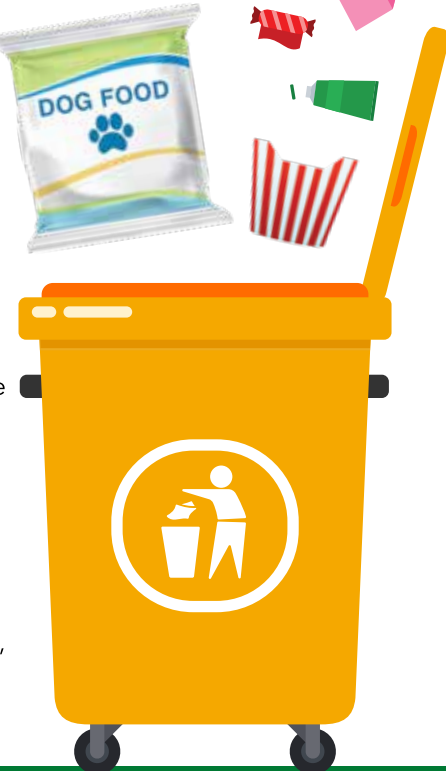
✗ Wet/dirty paper and cardboard

✗ Sticky notes

✗ Used paper plates, disposable nappies, tissues and toilet paper

✗ Wax-coated, foil-lined or laminated boxes

✗ Foil gift wrapping, carbon and laminated paper
